Uplift Youth Fund Applications Due June 30

Applications are still being accepted for the Uplift Youth Fund, a key initiative of our Community Pledge and a deepening commitment to the youth of Northern New Mexico. This summer's funding round has been bolstered by the generous donation of proceeds that will be raised from the sale of the resort's former Chair 7 lift chairs, doubling this award cycle from \$50,000 to \$100,000. Funding Overview

- Award Amounts: Awards will range between \$2,500 to \$10,000
- Total Funds Available: \$100,000 for the Summer 2025 cycle
- Funding Period: Projects may begin upon receipt of funds (anticipated early August 2025) and should be completed within a 12-month period
- This is the final cycle for 2025 and next year's cycle will be announced in January 2026
